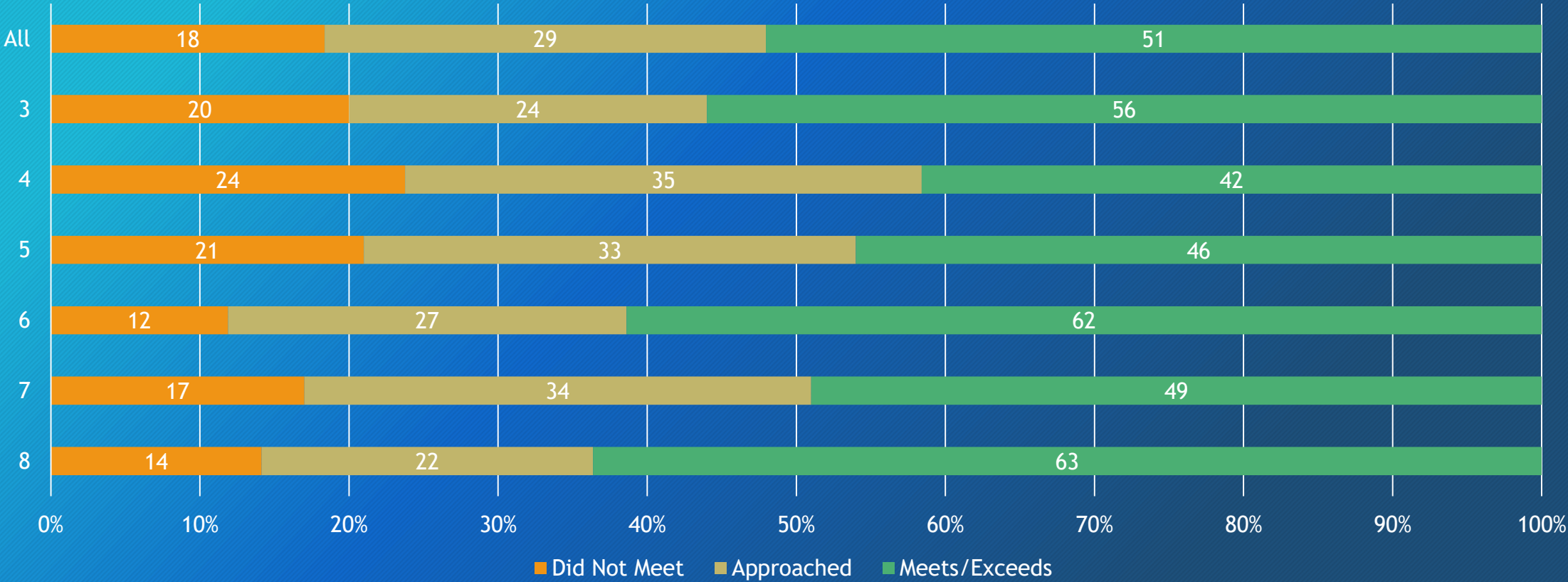


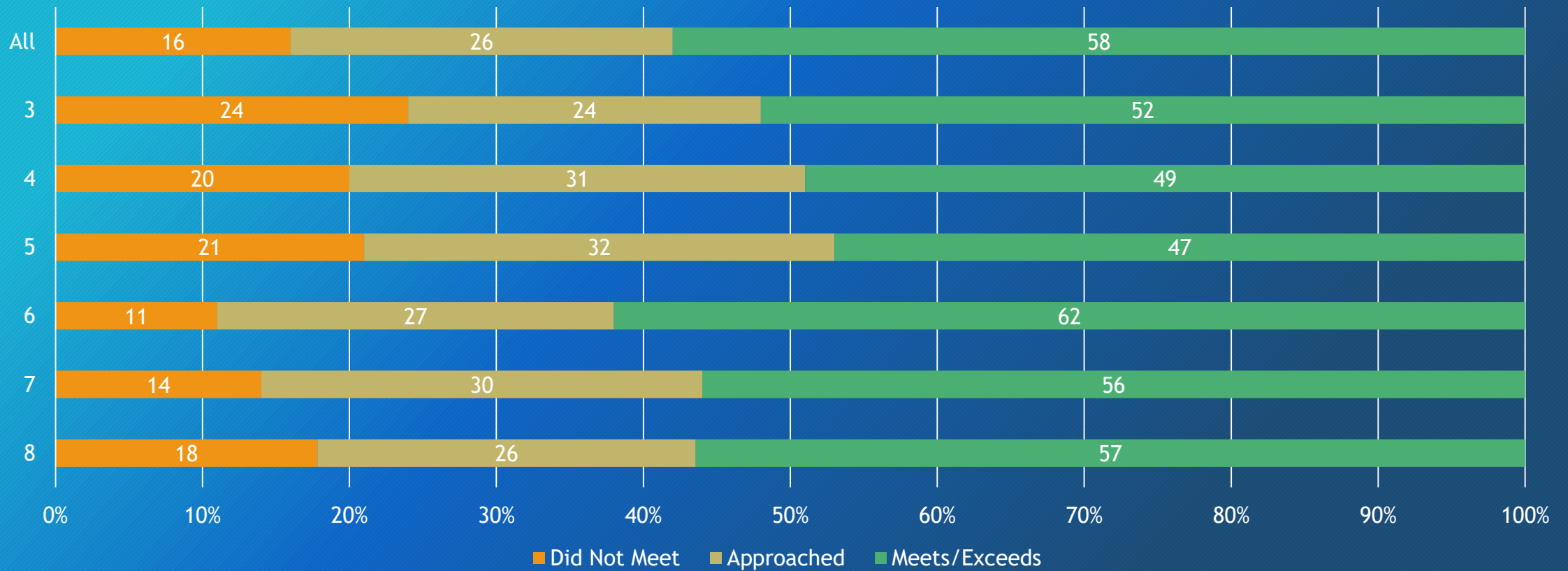

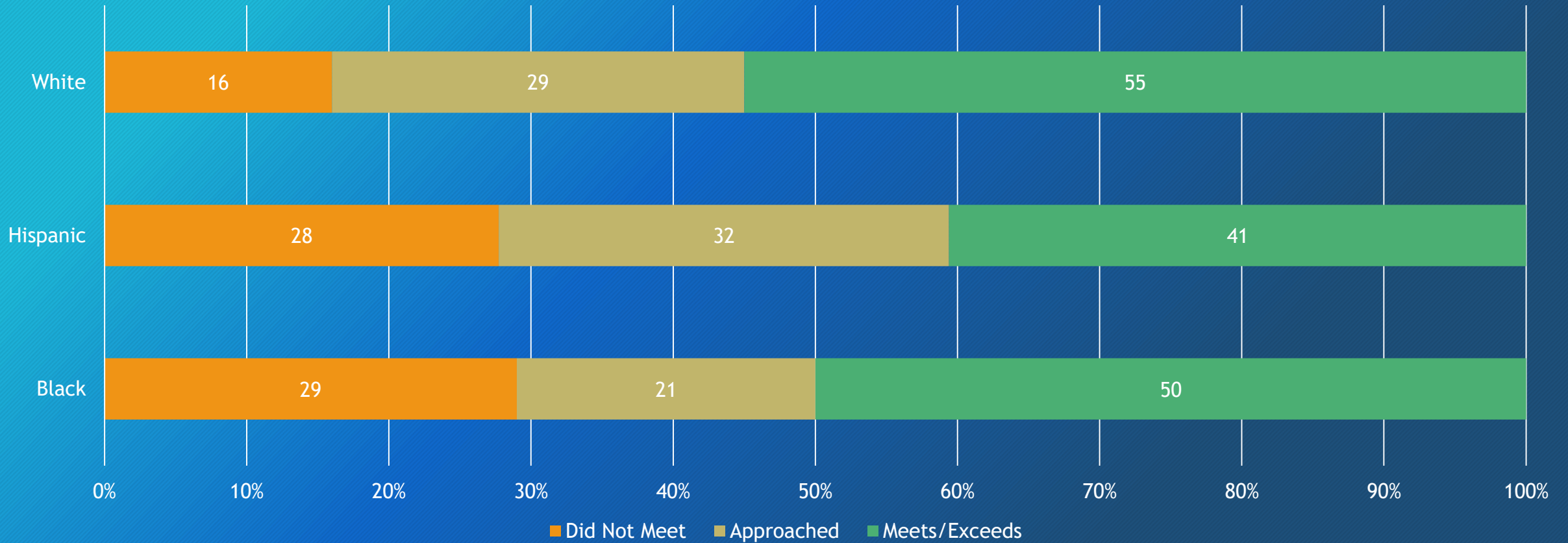
# District PARCC Achievement by Grade & ELA



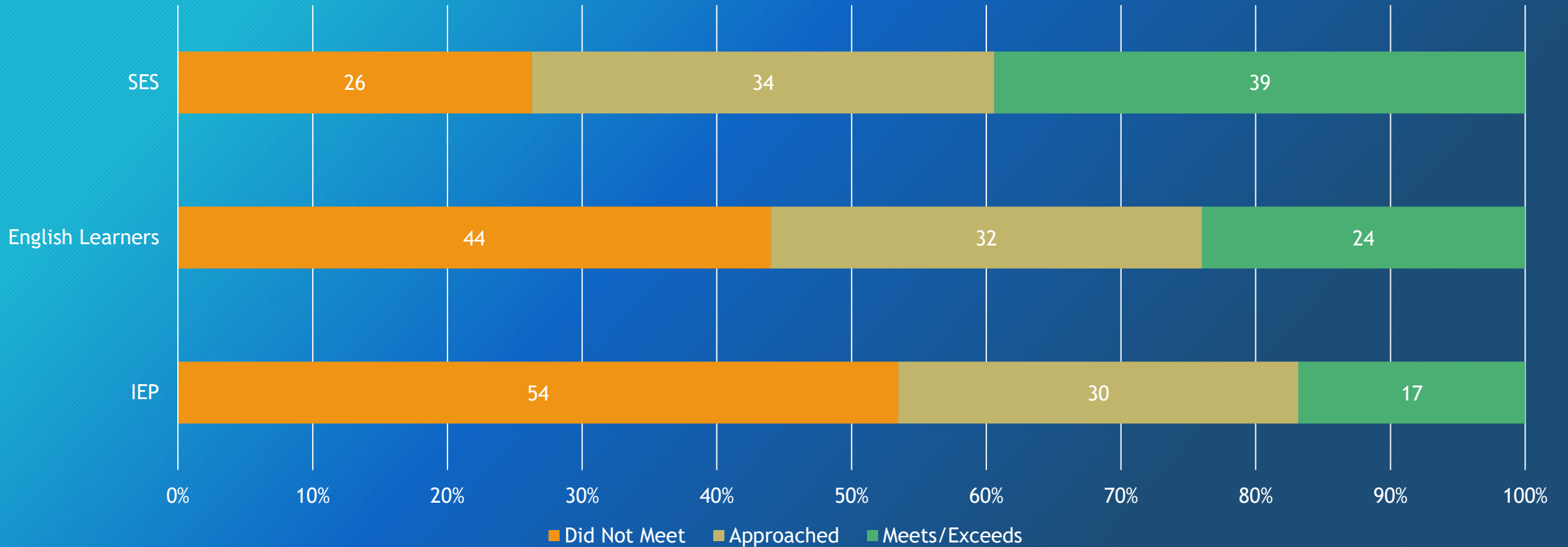
# District PARCC Achievement by Grade & Math

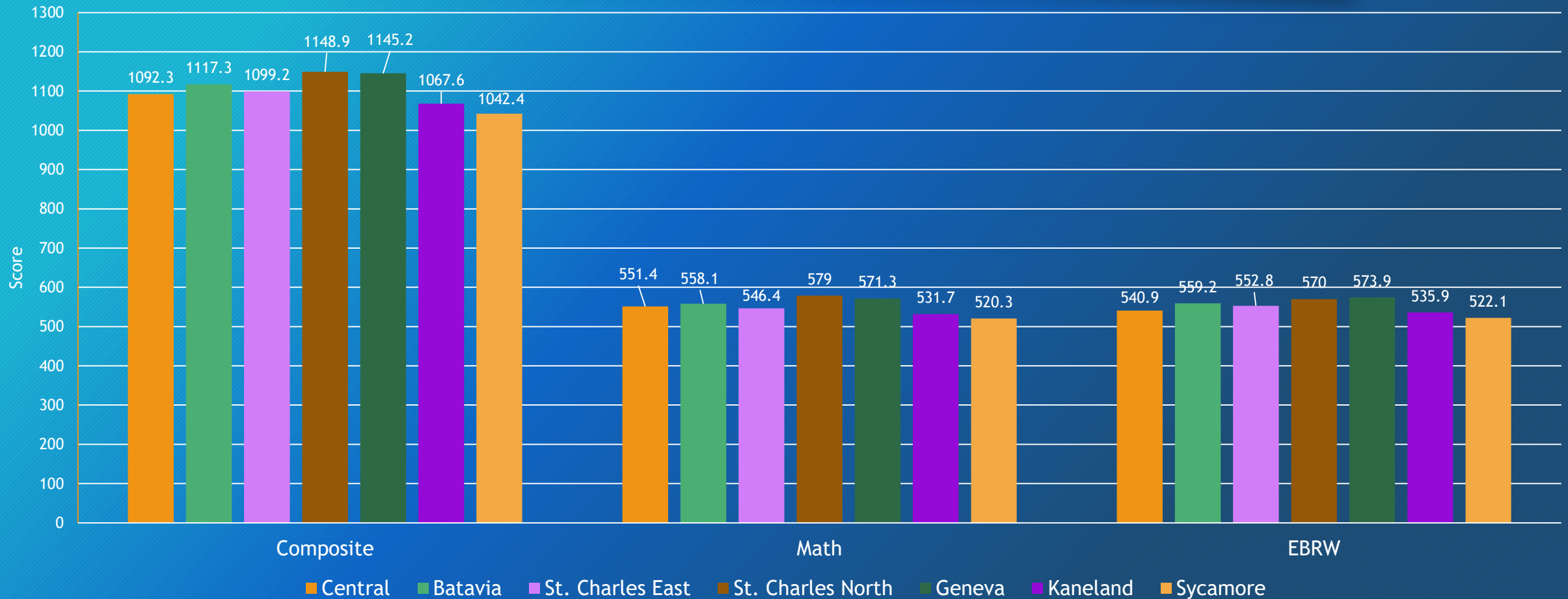

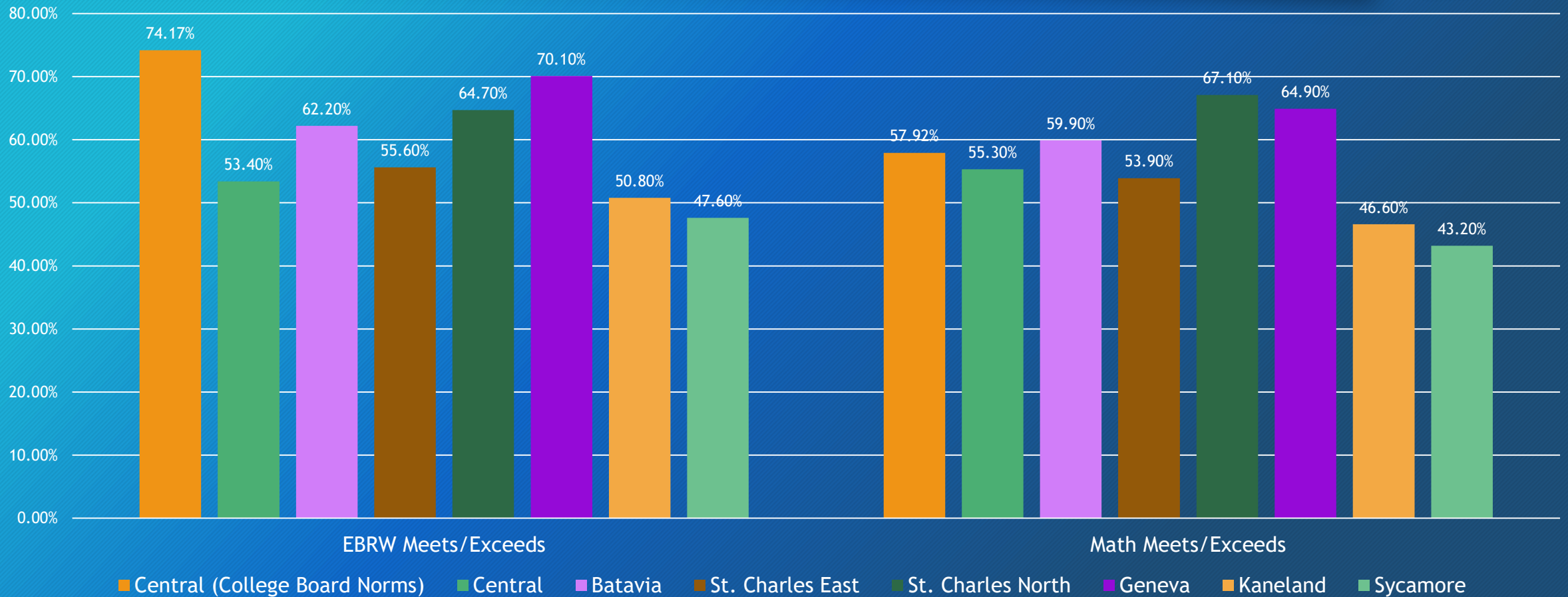

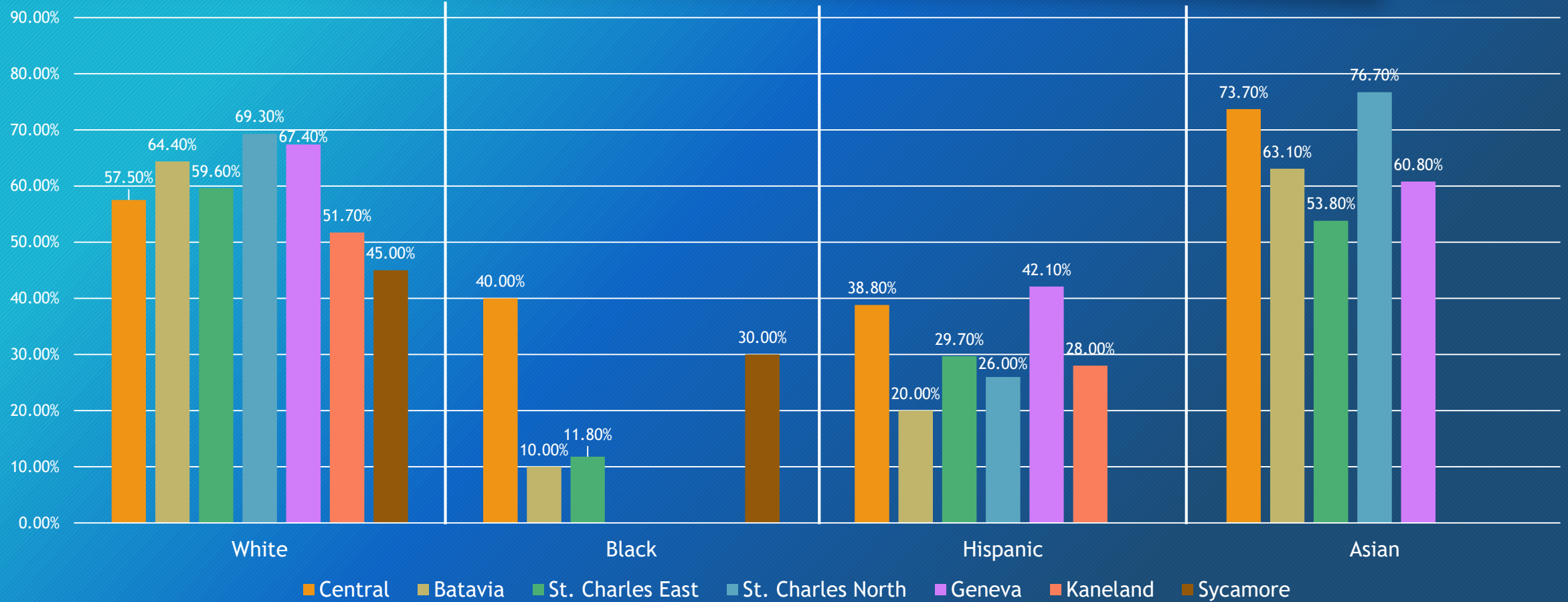

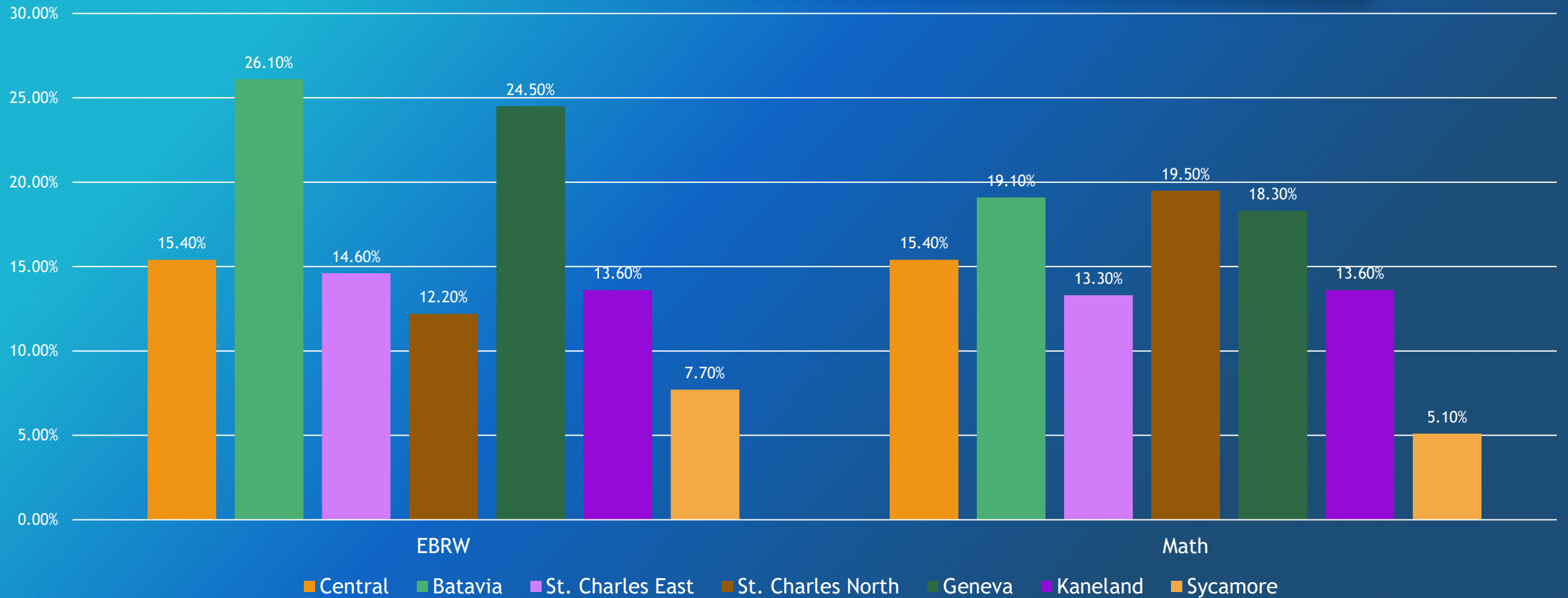

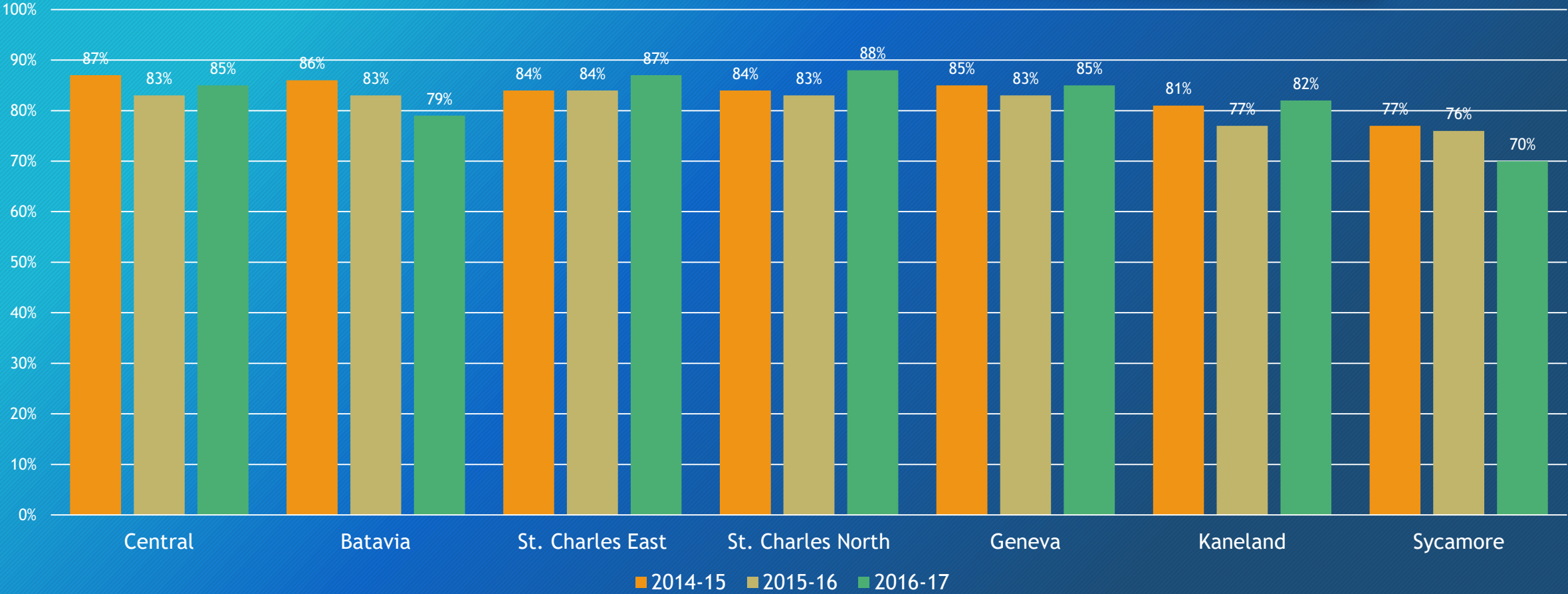
