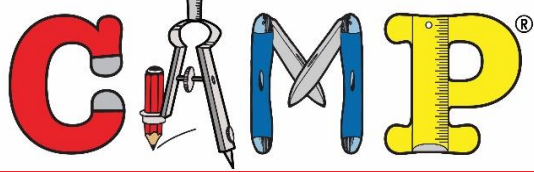

Students will engage and learn the fundamentals of MasterCam in order to design a medical device for cancer patients. Students will test their designs by printing 'mockups' using ECC's 3D printers. After the design phase, students will move to the CNC lab to learn how to program a Haas machine to manufacture the device. Students will test the same design with different materials to see differences in weaker materials. Final Product At the end of the camp, students will walk away with a prototype of a medical device.
