**Fact** – Average cost is \$500 per season. Teams also fundraise to reduce the cost of the season.

**Myth #4** – My kid will not make it, as he is not an elite player

**Fact** – Don't need to be an elite player. We take talented kids that have the drive to be better and make them better.

**Myth #5** – Not many openings on the Travel Teams

**Fact** – If there enough talent, we will create multiple teams at a grade level.
