

Central CUSD 301 - Erin's Law Compliance Plan 2020-21

Background Information: Erin Merryn is a sexual abuse survivor who has vowed her life to have this law passed in all 50 states. 37 states have passed the law, 11 more are introducing it. Illinois established a Task Force that created the guidelines below.

Key Components of the Erin's Law:

- All public schools in Illinois must implement a child abuse sexual prevention program in grades Pre-K through 12th.
- Programs should teach students to recognize abuse, equip themselves with skills to reduce vulnerability, and encourage them to speak up
- More than one session (ideally multiple sessions)
- Conducted annually
- Facilitated by a wide-range of personnel
- Evidence-based research should be used with an evaluation component
- PD for administrators, teachers, and any other staff that are mandated reporters
- Programs should encourage parental involvement

8th Grade	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Elgin Community Crisis Center will be providing booster lessons to all 8th grade students during “Task” to reinforce and expand on information presented to students in 6th – 7th grade
9th Grade	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● School Social Worker or Elgin Community Crisis Center will present program to each Health class
10th Grade	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● School Social Worker or Elgin Community Crisis Center will present program during the 20-21 school year
