SCHOOL BUS WINTER SAFETY

THE DO'S & DON'TS TO KEEP STUDENTS SAFE

DO	DON'T
Dress in warm winter clothing, jackets, gloves, hats, scarves and boots	Push or shove anyone at the bus stop, they can fall on the snow and ice
Allow extra time to get to your bus stop	Slide on icy patches on the driveway or street
Stay at least 10 feet from the edge of the street	Play on snow piles at the bus stop
Cross 10 feet in front of the bus so the driver can see you	Throw snow balls at the bus stop
Use the handrail when getting on and off the bus in case the steps are slippery	Come near the bus or grab the bus while it is moving
